Our selected terroirs



- West Languedoc: a temperate climate and very stony, chalky-clay soils producing very dense, aromatic wines.
- Central Languedoc: a hotter, earlier-ripening area, with gravelly clay and limestone soils giving noticeable but coated tannins.
- North-east: a cooler, later-ripening climate, with limestone soils providing fruitier wines.

Harvesting and vinification

The grapes are picked when perfectly ripe. They are carefully destemmed before undergoing lengthy maceration at less than 27°C to extract the tannins smoothly.

Maturing

The wines are fermented and matured in our winery in Sète, partly in French oak barrels and partly in vats to ensure the final blend has complexity without detracting from the fruit.

Tasting notes

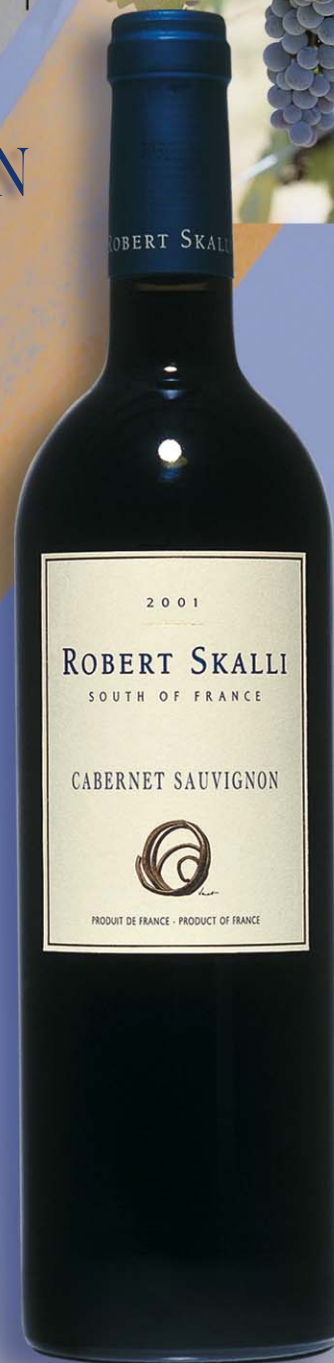
Purply red colour. Blackcurrant and bilberry notes fill the nose. Powerful aromas of dark fruit, pepper and coriander give ample, well-structured flavour to this dense and fruity wine.
